CPAWS-NL is currently looking for **volunteer stewards** for our **Protected Areas Steward Program**. Volunteer Stewards help to protect environmentally sensitive areas by conducting site visits and completing site visitation forms. Monitoring is ongoing, and protected sites are visited each season.

Volunteers must have a desire to **help protect environmentally sensitive areas**. Experience performing **outdoor activities** is an asset. Volunteers are responsible for ensuring their own safety by: exercising caution in the field, wearing proper footwear and clothing, and packing any needed supplies and provisions.

Volunteers are provided with an information package that outlines the information to be recorded during site visits. Office staff are readily available to provide support and answer questions.
