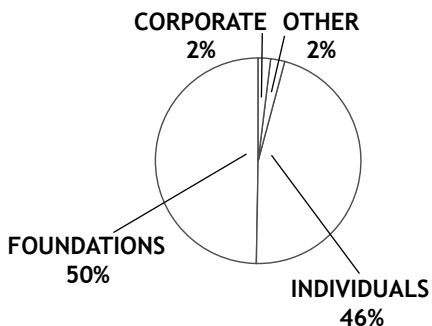

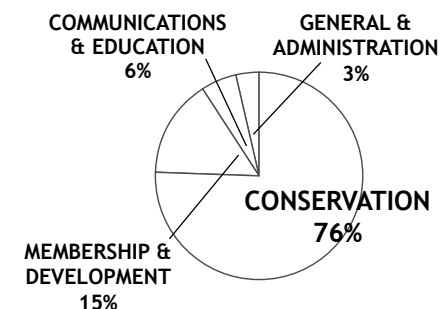
REVENUE

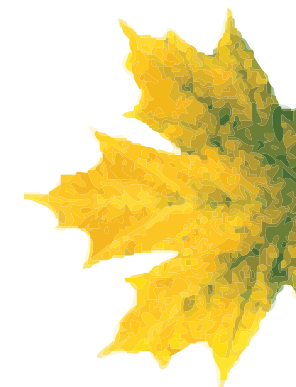

THE YEAR'S HIGHLIGHTS

- CPAWS launched the cross-Canada **Nahanni Forever tour** to build support for expanding Nahanni National Park Reserve to include the entire South Nahanni watershed. Host Harvey Locke was joined by well-known Canadians like Justin Trudeau, Cathy Jones, and Sarah Harmer, and scientists Drs. Derek Ford, John Weaver, and David Schindler. Ken James and Joanelle Swaen won the amazing **Nahanni trip for two** donated by Nahanni River Adventures.
- We launched a **brand new cpaws.org**, with extended news, information, and interactive options like an online action centre, and a new magazine, **Canadian Wilderness**.
- An exciting new phase began in CPAWS' partnership with **Mountain Equipment Co-op**.
- We published a **land use atlas** to help communities around Bruce Peninsula National Park put conservation first in their community planning.
- CPAWS Yukon's book, **Three Rivers: The Yukon's Great Boreal Wilderness** won glowing reviews and was a finalist for the 22nd annual BC Book Prize.
